In September, Louis-Cyprien Rials will be at Maison La Roche to present "Un stade en Irak".

The artist will share his vision of an emblematic yet little-known building: the Baghdad gymnasium, designed by Le Corbusier at the end of his life and completed after his death, which for a time bore the name of Saddam Hussein before housing a prison.



Access the Destinations Le Corbusier programme

The Heritage Mission, entrusted to Stéphane Bern and implemented by the Fondation du Patrimoine, has selected the project to restore Villa Stein de Monzie. The aim is to remedy the deterioration observed since 2015. The Fondation Le Corbusier supports this project, emphasising the urgent need to preserve this important architectural heritage.

The work is planned in two phases: the first concerns the west and north façades. This work is a priority because of the risk of falling cladding and structural instability. The second phase concerns the east and south façades, as well as the associated joinery.



FERNANDO ZAPARAÍN HERNÁNDEZ, SAVOYE AS BUILT


This book offers a 1:20 scale reconstruction of the house as it was built in 1930. Through a comparative study of plans, photographic analyses, in situ surveys and the development of a 3D model of the structure-envelope, the author offers a detailed study of the Villa Savoye. He also looks back at its history, from the first sketch to the controversial restorations of the 1960s.



RENATE BUSER, TYPICAL OBJECTS


Catalogue of the Objets-types exhibition at the Villa "Le Lac".
